- * Eliminates the possibility of a staff member adding money to a wrong account. The visitor selects the account and must verify that it is correct

“Cobra Cashier is designed to eliminate one of the most time consuming task our clients are faced with concerning resident accounting; the receiving and receipting of money for residents from a third party,” says Kelly Swanson, President. “Most facilities operate a window where visitors can bring money to the facility for residents. These windows are typically staffed by facility personnel. Cobra Cashier eliminates the need for money windows by allowing visitors to add money directly to a resident’s account through a Cobra Cashier kiosk.”
